

Petition for the Removal of Justice Matlow from the Bench for Anti-Christian Bias and Prejudice

We the undersigned support the Complaint dated May 12, 2012 made to the Canadian Judicial Council in respect of Justice P. T. Matlow for his removal from the Bench.

Justice Matlow's comments and actions, particularly in *Bedford v. Canada (A.G.)*, [2009] O.J. N. 2739 (S.C) **reveal prejudice, bigotry, and bias towards Christians**, or created an apprehension of bias such that he can no longer expect to enjoy the public's trust and has incapacitated himself from ever being perceived as impartial in future.

Justice Matlow’s comments at paragraphs 18, 22, and 23 reveal that to him arguments made by Christian Canadians are not legal arguments fitting for a court to consider, such argument are disruptive, and if the courts allow Christians to make arguments, which may reflect Christian values, it would appear that Courts are acting corruptly by providing Christians with a public platform to advance their principles, which he believes to be held by only small segments of Canadian society (a radical fringe).

A large segment of the Canadian population's trust in a fair and independent judiciary has been irreparably damaged so long as Justice Matlow remains on the Court.
